

II. ITINERARY

DAY 1

SIEM REAP ARRIVAL

Upon arrival in Siem Reap, you will embark on a captivating journey by Remork (Tuk Tuk) to APOPO HeroRats Visiting Centre. A guided tour through the Visitor Center gives you the chance to discover the history of conflict in Cambodia, the impact of landmines on local communities, and to meet and see the HeroRATs in action.

You will experience the realities of humanitarian demining and how APOPO trains their rats to save lives. It is a truly fascinating and different kind of tourist attraction, but one you are bound to enjoy. You will learn about landmines, how APOPO clears them, and see a live demo of the HeroRATs at work on a simulated minefield. Learn about how Cambodia became one of the most mine-affected countries in the world and what APOPO and its partners are doing to make it safe for the population.

DAY 2

SIEM REAP

Prepare for an exhilarating day of exploration with a full-day Angkor Tour by bicycle. Your adventure begins at the crown jewel of Khmer architecture, Angkor Wat, a national symbol and the pinnacle of Cambodian heritage. Pedal along the expansive moat, cross the Naga-adorned causeway, and step into a world of intricate carvings. Witness the celestial dancers gracing the walls and marvel at the world's longest continuous bas-relief, narrating tales from Hindu mythology. Experience the magic of Angkor Wat at sunrise and sunset for an unforgettable ambiance. Journey on to the fortified city of Angkor Thom, exploring iconic sights such as the South Gate, the Terrace of the Elephants, and the Bayon Temple with its giant stone faces. Ta Prohm, embraced by the jungle, captivates with its untouched allure.

DAY 3

SIEM REAP

Embark on a full-day cycling tour, commencing with a Tuk Tuk ride and a picturesque cycle through lush paddy fields. Explore the Roluos Group temples, including the pyramid-mountain temple Bakong and the Prasat Preah Ko.

Journey to the floating village of Kampong Phluk, where houses stand on stilts seven to eight meters above the water level, creating a captivating floating town. Glide by boat through narrow waterways. Everything lives on the water; people as well as animals, all jockeying for space in this incredible floating town. Stop by at the local pagoda, and venture in small rowing boats into the flooded forest. Return to Siem Reap by road.

DAY 4

SIEM REAP

Embark on a full-day adventure to Beng Mealea, a mystical temple surrounded by nature's embrace. Traverse its unrestored beauty, where sandstone towers and courtyards are adorned with flourishing trees. A visit to Banteay Srei follows, renowned for intricate friezes carved into red sandstone walls. Conclude the day by exploring Banteay Samre, a marvel from the 12th century. Before retreating to Siem Reap, stop at the Cambodia Landmine Museum. A visit here is shedding light on the impact of landmines on rural communities, providing mine awareness and education about these remnants of the war era.
