I. HIGHLIGHTS

- Imperial Hue & Perfume River – Explore Hue’s Imperial Citadel, Thien Mu Pagoda via a Dragon Boat ride, and the royal tombs of Tu Duc and Khai Dinh.
- Scenic Hai Van Pass & Cham Heritage – Journey through the Hai Van Pass and visit Danang’s Cham Museum, home to the world’s finest Cham sculptures.
- Historic Hoi An – Stroll through Hoi An’s UNESCO-listed ancient town, featuring the Japanese Covered Bridge, Fujian Assembly Hall, and traditional merchant houses.
- My Son Sanctuary – Discover the ancient Cham ruins of My Son, a UNESCO World Heritage site showcasing Vietnam’s Hindu-influenced past.

II. ITINERARY

DAY 1

HUE

Upon arrival at Hue airport, transfer to your hotel for check in (early check in is not included). Hue was Vietnam’s feudal capital from 1802 to 1945 under the Nguyen dynasty. It is widely known for the magnificent architecture of its citadels, palaces, royal tombs, pagodas and temples set in a poetic background of greenery on the banks of the Perfume River. All were laid out in harmony with nature and in accordance with the principles of geomancy (Feng Shui). Besides monuments, Hue still retains much of its past glory in daily routines and activities in religion, gastronomy, handicraft, music, the performing arts and traditional festivals. Hue became Vietnam’s first World Cultural Heritage site recognized by UNESCO in 1993. The remaining day is at leisure.

DAY 2

HUE

ing Tour:

Start your day with a 40-minute Dragon Boat ride along the Perfume River to Thien Mu Pagoda, an iconic Buddhist site in Hue. The pagoda features the seven-story Phuoc Duyen Tower and a monastic complex where visitors can see the car used by Thich Quang Duc before his historic self-immolation in 1963.

Next, explore the Imperial Citadel, the former seat of the Nguyen Dynasty. Enter via a stone bridge to see the grand Thai Hoa Palace, adorned with gold-lacquered columns, and enjoy a one-hour pedicab ride to take in the vast citadel and daily life within its walls.

Afternoon Tour:

Visit the tomb of Emperor Tu Duc, set in a lush pine forest 8 km from Hue, showcasing exquisite Nguyen Dynasty architecture. Then, explore the tomb of Emperor Khai Dinh, an elaborate structure blending Vietnamese and European influences, located on the slopes of Chau Chu Mountain. End your tour with a stop at a village famous for producing incense sticks and traditional Vietnamese conical hats.

DAY 3

HUE – DANANG – HOI AN

After breakfast, transfer from Hue to Hoi An via the scenic Hai Van Pass, stopping en route at the Cham Museum in Danang. Housed in a French colonial building, the museum holds the world's finest collection of Cham sculpture.

Upon arrival in Hoi An, check in to your hotel before exploring this well-preserved former trading port. Despite centuries of weather and war, the town's historic center remains largely unchanged. A guided walking tour offers insight into Hoi An's rich past, beginning at the Culture and History Museum. Stroll through the authentic local market before visiting the 17th-century Fujian Assembly Hall, dedicated to Thien Hau, the Goddess of the Sea.

Continue along charming streets lined with old merchant houses and colorful lantern-lit shops. Visit the iconic Japanese Covered Bridge, built in the early 17th century by Japanese traders, now a symbol of Hoi An. Conclude the tour with a visit to a historic home, showcasing the town's unique heritage as a UNESCO-listed site.

Embark on a half day excursion to My Son: My Son is the former capital of the ancient Cham civilization that ruled central Vietnam from the 2nd to 13th century. The Cham religion was primarily derived from Indian Hinduism. My Son is considered to be one of the best-preserved Cham structures in Vietnam. The complex comprises 70 Hindu-like towers and temples dating from the second century. This site is a must-see for anyone interested in architecture and ancient civilization and is one of five UNESCO World Heritage sites in Vietnam
